Having produced several internationally screened and award-winning short films, Paul became a recipient of Screen Australia Enterprise funding, securing a placement at Blue Rocket Productions to be mentored as a creative producer. Since then Paul has worked as an associate producer on children's animated series, *Dumbotz*, for Nine Network and has produced a short documentary, *Sidelines*, for SBS and an animated web-series, *Moments of Clarity*.

Most recently Paul produced *KEEKO*, an educational children's animated interstitial series for ABC and is currently developing several projects for various platforms. Paul currently serves as a board member for Wide Angle Tasmania and has been selected as one of Screen Producers Australia's "Ones to Watch."
